Formal Graduation Ceremony Handbook

This handbook provides all details for families considering participation in the **AliYah Academy Graduation Ceremony**. Please read carefully, as it outlines expectations, deadlines, fees, and event logistics.

1. Celebrating Your Graduate

Come celebrate in style with us!

AliYah Academy offers a **traditional cap and gown commencement ceremony** held in Knoxville, Tennessee. This ceremony is **optional** and is designed to honor and celebrate your student's achievement alongside family, mentors, and peers.

Please note: Your student's **diploma and official transcripts are already included** with your Senior membership. The ceremony is an additional opportunity to celebrate together as a community.

The ceremony is typically held on the **first or second Thursday in June**.

2. What's Included

The Graduation Ceremony package includes:

- Elegant venue in Knoxville, Tennessee
- Professional photographer capturing the event
- Keynote speaker
- Student speaker (audition-based)
- Student talent performances (audition-based)
- **Five (5) guest seats** per graduate
 - Additional seats available for purchase (\$10 each)

The ceremony takes place in the beautiful ballroom of **The Grande Event Center**, creating a memorable and meaningful experience for your family.

3. Registration & Fees

Due to upfront venue, staffing, and production costs, **no refunds** can be issued for any reason. Please ensure your decision before submitting payment.

- Parent and Student Check-in & student board setup: **2:00 PM**
 - Rehearsal: **2:15 PM – 3:30 PM** (*Parents and Students both need to be here so you understand where to go and stand*)
 - Free Time: **3:30 PM - 5:00 PM**
 - Parents and Students come back: **5:00 PM**
 - Guest seating opens: **5:30 PM**
 - Fellowship, photography & refreshments until: **8:30 PM**
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5. Student Speaker & Talent Auditions

Auditions for **Student Speaker** and **Student Talent** are held during the **last week of April**.

This is an opportunity for students to:

- Encourage and inspire their peers
- Publicly acknowledge parents and mentors

Families must **register for the Graduation Ceremony first**, then call to schedule an audition time.

6. Parent & Student Responsibilities

To participate in the Graduation Ceremony, families must complete the following:

Required

- **Cap & Gown**
 - Order a **Shiny Royal Blue** cap and gown to be shipped to your home (*we have a link on our website*)
 - Tassel color is your choice
 - Caps are allowed to be decorated if desired (*no foul language is permitted, keep it clean*)
 - Sashes, Stoles, and Cords are optional and may be worn in the color of your choice (*AliYah Academy does not designate a valedictorian*)
 - Orders should be placed promptly to allow for shipping

Gowns from previous graduates may only be reused if they are **Shiny Royal Blue** for event uniformity.

- **Graduation Slideshow Photos**
 - **Three (3) student photos**
 - Suggested photos: early childhood, middle years, high school (or all senior photos)
 - Please ensure high-quality images suitable for large-screen projection
 - Upload under **Files** by **April 1**
- **Student Bio**
 - 2–3 sentences written in **third person**
 - Highlight achievements, interests, passions, or future goals
 - These are read aloud by the announcer as the parent presents the diploma to the Graduate and has their photo taken on stage
 - Upload under **Files** by **April 1**
- **Dress Code**
 - This is a formal event
 - **Graduates** should wear **business or dress attire** under the gown with **black dress shoes**
 - **Parents** should also wear **business or dress attire**, as parents will be on stage and photographed while presenting the diploma

Optional

- Create a **Student Display Board** for the entrance lobby
 - Prepare a **speech** and audition for **Student Speaker**
 - Prepare a **song/performance** and audition for **Student Talent**
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7. Graduation Requirements*

Participation in the Graduation Ceremony does **not automatically confirm graduation eligibility**.

Parents are responsible for ensuring that their student has met all **AliYah Academy graduation requirements**, including completion of all required core credits and submission of final grades by the stated deadlines.

Please carefully review the **High School Handbook** and confirm that no core credits are missing before requesting Graduation Ceremony. If you have any questions about your student's credit status, contact the office well in advance of deadlines so we may assist you.

AliYah Academy has the final determinations regarding graduation, transcripts, and ceremony participation.

*See the **High School Handbook** for all Graduation requirements.

8. Guest Tickets & Seating

- **5 guest seats included** per graduate
- Up to **5 additional seats** may be purchased for **\$10 each**
- After **March** additional seats may be available if space allows (*we will begin taking payments for additional seats April 13*)

All seating must be **paid for in advance**. We are unable to sell seats at the door.

Please note: Physical tickets are **not issued**. We will have staff at the entrance to check in each graduate's family and friends. Guests will provide the graduate's name at check-in so our staff can verify their registration number. Guests will then receive a wristband upon arrival based on the number of registered guests.

Infants or babies who will be **held in someone's lap** do not require a purchased seat. If a child will occupy their own seat, a seat must be purchased.

9. Additional Information

- Masks are **not required**
 - Space is limited
 - All ceremony fees are **non-refundable**
 - The stage is accessed by stairs. If a parent or student is unable to use stairs, please notify us in advance so we can make appropriate accommodations.
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10. Senior Shirt

Families may order an optional **Senior Shirt** for an **additional cost** when available. The Senior Shirt is **not included** with the Graduation Ceremony package.

To order a Senior Shirt:

1. Log in to your account
2. Select the **Events** tab
3. Choose **Senior Shirt Order***

*We post on **Facebook, Band,** and our **website** when ordering is available.

11. Communication

AliYah Academy uses the **BAND app** to communicate important ceremony updates with participating families.

BAND will be used for:

- Event reminders and timeline updates
- Ceremony logistics and announcements
- Sharing **professional photos** taken at the ceremony (*photos will be sent through a link and will expire after 14 days*)
- Posting important last-minute information
